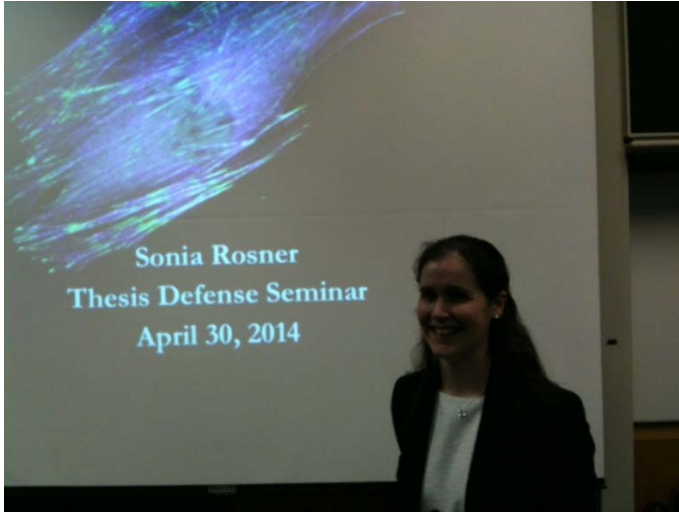


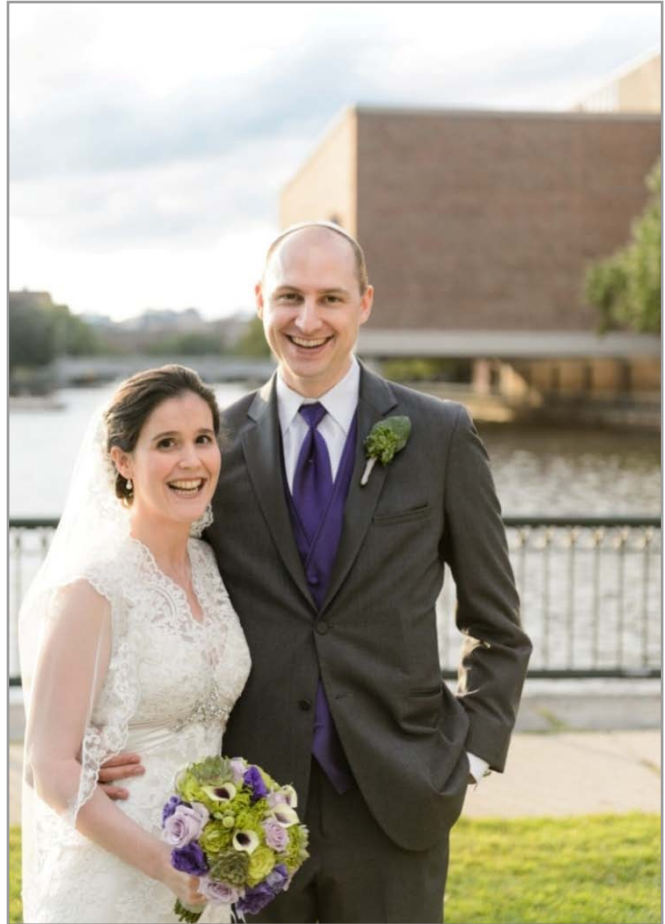
Happy New Year from the Rosner family!
